When do we meet?

Every Wednesday morning from 7:30-8:30. On months with a 5th Wednesday we will meet offsite at a local business or non-profit to learn about their impact on Columbia.

Our meetings feature weekly speakers from all over the city ranging from business owners to non-profits to celebrities.

How do we serve?

Our four main service projects are:

1. **Wreath Sales** – Our annual fundraiser, club members sell or purchase a set number of wreaths in December. Funds collected from the wreaths are for scholarships to local high school students for college tuition.
2. **Meals on Wheels** – Two members from the club will deliver hot meals on Fridays to those that cannot provide for themselves. Normally, each member will deliver twice in a calendar year for 1-2 hours.
3. **Dictionary Project** – Teams of club members deliver dictionaries and spend time with local 4th graders in schools throughout the city. Normally a one-hour time commitment per year.
4. **Blood Drive** – Our annual blood drive is held in July benefitting the American Red Cross.

What else do we do?

There are two socials in the calendar year, in the spring and our annual Holiday Social in December. This is strictly a social event for members and their guests.

What does it cost?

The cost is \$195 per quarter with \$60 going to dues, \$25 going to the Rotary Foundation and \$110 for the breakfast.
